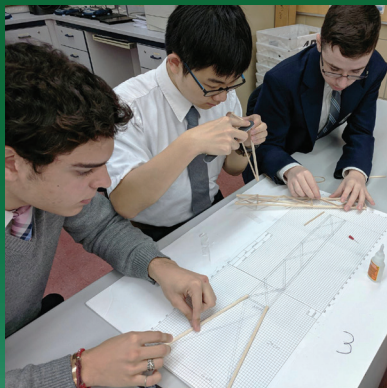

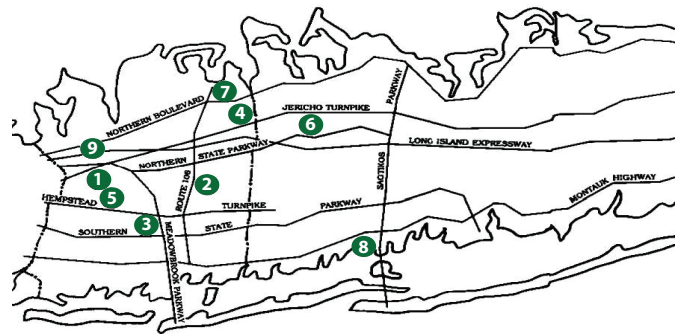


DATES TO REMEMBER

ABOUT THE EXAM

TEST FOR ADMISSION TO CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOLS



Students who plan to apply to one or more Catholic high schools on Long Island must take the Test for Admission to Catholic High Schools (TACHS). **The exam will be administered online on Saturday, Nov. 6, 2021.** The exam will be administered with accommodations for extended time only. There is a \$65 non-refundable registration fee. Students must register for the exam without accommodations by Friday, Oct. 24, 2021. The preferred method of registration is online registration. This method is more accurate and provides immediate confirmation and admissions tickets. Visit www.tachsinfo.org to register. Students also may register by telephone, using 1-866-618-2247. Registering students by telephone is similar to the Internet method in that information will be collected for each student individually. All telephone registrations are handled by a live operator. Telephone registration is available Monday-Friday from 8:00am-7:00pm and Saturday-Sunday from 10:00am-2:00pm (ET). If English is not the native language of the caller, an operator speaking that persons' language will be made available.

The exam with extended time accommodations requires a separate form to be submitted for students to qualify for taking the exam with accommodations. The IEP or evaluation form must be submitted with the eligibility form in order to qualify by October 8, 2021. Please visit the TACHS website, www.tachsinfo.org to download the eligibility form. Please print and complete the eligibility form, and then email it along with the IEP or 504 evaluation form to support-a@chsee.org

SCHOOL REGISTRATION

Notification of acceptance to a particular high school will be made in mid-January. Students and families will be informed of all necessary registration procedures. At that time, many schools require the payment of a registration fee.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

TEST FOR ADMISSION TO CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOLS

1 What is the purpose of this examination?

The Test for Admission to Catholic High Schools (TACHS) gives some objective data about 8th-grade students who are applying to Catholic high school. The Catholic high schools use the examination results to make decisions about applicants. Many schools also use the information for grouping and tracking of 9th-grade students.

2 Who should take this test?

This test is only for 8th-grade students seeking entrance into a Catholic high school in the 9th grade. Other transfer students should contact the school(s) of their choice for admissions procedures. 7th-grade students are not permitted to take the test.

3 What does the examination measure?

The examination measures both ability and achievement. Achievement is measured in the areas of reading, mathematics, and written expression.

4 How does an 8th-grade student register to take the examination?

Only 8th-grade students may take the entrance exam. Online registration, which is available beginning August 24th, is the preferred method of registration (visit www.tachsinfo.org for online registration). Students also may register by telephone, using 1-866-618-2247. There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$65.

5 Is the test offered with testing accommodations?

Students who pre-qualify for testing accommodations (extended time only) by submitting appropriate documents and application. Online applications and documentation uploads are due by October 8, 2021. For more information about testing accommodations, visit the TACHS website at www.tachsinfo.org.

6 May a student take the exam without accommodations and also with accommodations?

EXAM PROCEDURES

TEST FOR ADMISSION TO CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOLS

1 Review the email sent to you post registration, for other important information.

2 Review the online remote testing system and device requirements prior to the exam.
(*found at www.tachsinfo.com*).

All students taking the exam must use:

- Current version of the Chrome web browser with the Proctorio Chrome extension (see www.tachsinfo.com for setup directions)
- High speed Internet connection
- Internal or external microphone
- Internal or external webcam

Please note: iPads, virtual machines and proxy connections are not supported

3 Review the Student Handbook which includes sample test questions. (*found at www.tachsinfo.com*)

4 Between Nov. 2 and Nov. 5, access your *Find my test session code/date/times* on tachsinfo.com. You will not be able to start your test session on the day/time of testing without this information.

5 Be on time. Begin the log-in process no less than 30 minutes prior to your test session time. Students logging in more than 10 minutes after their test session begins, will not be able to enter the exam.
